
The focus of the Diploma project is the transformation and repurposing of the former Municipal Abattoir in Bucharest, located at 162 Splaiul Unirii Boulevard, on the right bank of the Dâmbovița River. The proposal aims to redevelop this former industrial site into an integrated Arts and Science Park, leveraging its historical significance while addressing contemporary urban challenges. A comprehensive qualitative research approach was employed to explore the site's historical context. This included archival research, discussions with the site administrator, photographic documentation, and an extensive literature review. This strategy aimed to uncover the site's evolution, operational history, and architectural changes, situating it within a broader historical and cultural framework. Additionally, the research was conducted to support further studies for the master's dissertation. The findings from this research will be revealed in this annex.

#### general information

#### GENERAL

The chosen location for the pre-diploma foundattions study is situated at 162 Splaiul Unirii Boulevard in sector 4, Bucharest. This area was previously occupied by the old Municipal Slaughterhouse. The site is bounded by Splaiul Unirii Boulevard, Mihai Bravu Boulevard, Calea Vacaresti, and Abatorului Boulevard.

In terms of its proximity to the city center, the site is favorably located, being only 3 kilometers away. It covers a total area of 47,000 square meters and is adjacent to significant landmarks such as the Mihai-Bravu Passage, Vacaresti National Park, and Children's Park. Additionally, it offers direct access to the Dambovita River.



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




The density of the built-up area is low, the unbuilt area predominates, mainly used as agricultural land.

The street grid is organic, irregular and non-hierarchical, delimiting islands of the same nature.

The fabric is traditional, with small houses on the farm plot, organized around the places of worship, reflecting the late rurality of the capital in the mid-19th

"Gardina cu Duzi" lot can be distinguished which later in the 1850s will be chosen by the municipality to be the site on which the slaughterhouse project will be located.

1869 The Slaughter House Pavilions appear. The construction was made according to the plans of the architect Alexis Godillot, handed over to the City Hall of the Municipality of Bucharest in 1868

1880-1883- the first the first sewerage work of Dambovita

The site is still at the outskirts of the city; other industrial sites appear such as, Lemaitre foundry factory, Cotton industry.

Urban islands take on more regular shapes due to the development of the street system. The area is becoming densified with the growth of the population and the improvement of the infrastructure.

An important sign of the transformations at the level of the urban tissue are the appearance of "cul de sac", a sign of the densification of the plots on the urban islands; some of them will later be transformed into streets.


Important changes take place during


communism, through Ceausescu's systematization projects, entire areas of single-family houses with gardens are demolished and in their place bedroom neighborhoods with medium-height blocks appear, gradually the fronts appear, then construction is also built behind them. Tineretului Park is also created, and the works for Lacul Vacaresti start, but are never finished. Mihai-Bravu bridge appears in the 80s.




The area developed significantly after the revolution, becoming a semi-central area, located only 3km from the city center. The area becomes attractive for real estate developers, tall and medium-rise residential buildings and high-rise office buildings appear. The former industrial halls are reclaimed and artistic


cooperatives appear around them.
The Mhai-Bravu - Vacaresti passage was completed in 2014.
Vegetation grows on the platform of Lake Vacaresti, and the area becomes a true natural area, later gaining the status of a protected area and a National Park.






















The site of the Diploma project is situated at Splaiul Unirii 162 Boulevard in Bucharest, District 4, positioned on the right bank of the Dambovita River.

Initially chosen in the mid-19th century, the location was strategically situated on the outskirts of the city, conveniently positioned on the right bank of the Dambovita River, where the river exited the city. This placement is crucial as the slaughterhouse operations relied heavily on water, with waste being directed downstream to manage pollution within the city, while awaiting for the installation of purification and disinfection stations. The first measures to set up a


modern slaughterhouse were taken in France in 1807, when it was officially required that the location of the slaughterhouses be near the water, on a vast land, allowing for further expansions. Bucharest's Abattoir followed the same logic.

#### **APPROACH**


A multifaceted qualitative research approach was used to explore the site's historical context, involving archival research, discussions, photographic documentation, and a thorough literature review, such as Liviu Chelcea's Post-Industrial Bucharest: Memory, Deindustrialization, and Urban Regeneration and Description du Nouvel Abattoir de Bucarest: Construction, Agencement et Exploitation by Nicolae Slăniceanu. This strategy aimed to uncover the site's evolution, operational history, and architectural changes, placing it within a broader historical and cultural framework.

Documents from Bucharest's National Municipal archives and an architectural survey from the 1980s were reviewed. Any missing information was supplemented with structural studies and discussions with the site administrator. After a thorough analysis and coordination of all data, architectural surveys of the original buildings were conducted.

#### CONCLUSION

The proposed intervention aims to restore the buildings to their 1910 state, not through imitation but by subtraction, revealing the original openings beneath the plaster and insulation. The plan intends to preserve all original metallic structures, restoring or replacing them with identical elements where needed. For entrances, the original window placements will serve as a guide, and main halls will have interior partitions removed to showcase the metallic structure, with additional functions accommodated in new standalone volumes.


The state of preservation of the hall is bad, the metal structure is preserved, but inside there are various improvisations that divide the central space for different activities.




# STATE OF CONSERVATION

The four administrative buildings, and the oldest of the whole, are relatively well preserved due to the fact that they were always in use. Various changes to the window openings also appear here.



The sanitary slaughter house is in a very bad state of degradation, part of the building being abandoned, some of the rooms of the building have been transformed into workshops, the original form of the building is unknown, new door and window openings can be observed.



# parasites.

The area enjoys strong connectivity to the broader city through public transportation networks. However, it is noteworthy that vehicular traffic is significantly congested within the area, particularly on the prominent regional and urban arteries, namely Splaiul Unirii Boulevard and Calea Vacaresti. In contrast, the local streets within the area primarily accommodate pedestrian circulation, with minimal vehicle traffic.

#### CONCLUSION:

To enhance pedestrian and cyclist mobility and establish better local connectivity, it is recommended to remove the surrounding wall. This would facilitate movement from Splaiul Unirii Boulevard to Calea Vacaresti within the site, improving access to public transport stations and the park. This redesign would also eliminate the need to navigate the heavily trafficked and high-speed area near the Mihai-Bravu Passage for pedestrians and cyclists.



#### 1.STREET SYSTEM

The street layout in the studied area underscores its primary focus on accommodating automobiles. The area comprises broad boulevards with heavy traffic flow, which predominantly handle both local and urban traffic, channeling it towards the city exits and the Mihai-Bravu-Vacaresti overpass.







#### 2. BUILT-UNBUILT

The examination of the built environment highlights the primary categories of structures within the surveyed area:

residential blocks characteristic of dormitory neighbourhoods in Timpuri Noi, Tineretului, Mihai Bravu, and Vitan neighborhoods.

low-rise houses, emerging during phases of urban densification.

high-rise residential real estate developments, notably proliferating since the 2000s.

# 3.PERMEABILITY OF URBAN ISLANDS.



A former industrial site, where traffic was well controlled, the studied site is surrounded by a thick wall, and access to the site is only through the side on Splaiul Unirii Boulevard, through a single gate. Permeability at the level of the urban island is very poor.

After the 2000s, after the spaces are given for rent to various small companies, divisions appear in the spaces of the former slaughterhouse halls, after which extensions to the street and additions begin to appear.

These new annexes and extensions parasitize the original buildings and block their facades from the street.

CONCLUSION: It is proposed to keep the buildings of great architectural importance and eliminate the parasitic buildings.






























The analysis from the case studies identified key strategies for intervening in industrial sites with uncomfortable heritage aspects. Techniques from Parc de la Villette and Plaza Matadero, such as Tchumi's logic of points, lines, and surfaces, along with Ginés Garrido, Carlos Rubio, and Fernando Porra's pavement hierarchy, will be employed in the park design. For the interior layout of the buildings, strategies from Arturo Franco's Intermediae and Virseda & Vila's Nave 16 foldable panel systems will be adapted for the exhibition spaces in the former slaughterhouses. Casa del Lector offers insights into arranging a mediatheque and an auditorium. Multiplexity offers a base for theme requirements and dimensioning.


